## **Transport Review Archive Catalogue**

Formed in June 1963, in demand to an appetite for transport news in the Grimsby area, the Lincolnshire Transport Review has grown to become the definitive transport archive and resource for passenger transport operators and services in the county. To the present day, and following two name changes to reflect the expansion in coverage, each edition contains local news stories as well as fleet news for bus and coach operators. Since its inception, fleet changes affecting Lincolnshire Road Car have been covered in every edition, with Grimsby-Cleethorpes Transport receiving the same meticulous coverage even to the present day under Stagecoach ownership. The Lincolnshire Transport Review was there in the early 1970s, when so much of Lincolnshire's railway was closed. As operations north of the Humber expanded, we've covered EYMS fleet news in all editions from the late-1960s.

With operator and railway fleet news and a standardised news section in all editions, this booklet aims to showcase the number of articles published and the depth of coverage given. If there's a particular time during the last 60 years you're interested in, use this booklet to see what articles were published at that time and maybe consider purchasing that volume? We hope to offer this fascinating and unique historical record of local passenger transport operations to as many people as possible. We are sure that there is something for everyone's interest over the last six decades.
